

Tracy-Gene G. Durkin Named Vice Chair of USPTO's Patent Public Advisory Committee

"I am incredibly honored to be selected for this prestigious post on the USPTO's PPAC," said Durkin. "The committee's work related to patent operations is vital to all those who use the nation's patent system, and I look forward to serving as its Vice Chair over the next year."

On December 16, 2021, the USPTO issued a <u>press release</u> announcing Durkin's and other PPAC appointments.
