The Work

- One associate discussed the variety and significance of work, noting the opportunity to "work directly with inventors, attend depositions, and respond to opposing counsel."
- "I have had a lot of assignments a normal junior wouldn't get, including the chance to draft expert reports and motions," said another associate, highlighting the responsibilities entrusted to associates at the firm.

Career Development

- Directors are consistently mentoring junior associates and making themselves available
 for guidance. One associate shared that the firm has "a really strong professional
 development program," and that directors are "really invested in your development."
- When discussing preparations for the role, one junior noted that new associates could expect "a slew of onboarding and training for anything and everything you could be doing as an attorney."

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion

- The editors of Chambers Associate report that "Sterne [Kessler]'s commitment to DE&I is reflected in the fact that it ranks among the top 10% of firms surveyed for its representation of ethnic minority partners."
- "We have an excellent executive committee who is invested in the progression, retention, and recruitment of diverse associates," remarked one associate, emphasizing the firm-wide commitment to creating a workplace that embraces diversity.

Culture

 While the firm is flexible and accommodating on working remotely and in the office, many employees have chosen to return to the office for the unique, personable culture.
 One associated contributed, "the reason I'm going into the office is to socialize and build relationships," adding that "I've been surprised at how genuinely open everyone is people try to get to know you beyond the surface level."
